



## TIS Anti-Bullying Policy

June 2008

The Tabubil International School takes a strong stance against any form of bullying in the school. Bullying is understood to encompass verbal taunts, exclusion of persons from activities as well as unwarranted physical contact.

Students, teachers, school workers and parents at TIS have the right to be free of bullying. All members of the school community are to abstain from bullying others in any way; to actively discourage bullying when it occurs and to give support to those who are victimised.

Victims of bullying are encouraged to report these incidents to staff members and / or the administration. Reported cases of bullying will be followed up by staff members or the school administration with appropriate action. Victims will be given help and support.

Those who bully others will be dealt with appropriately. This may include counselling, the imposition of sanctions, interviews with parents and in extreme cases suspension from school.

Tabubil International School follows and implements the program called '[Taking Action](#)' across the school.
