School Association AGM

The Tabubil International School Association will be holding its Annual General Meeting on Wednesday, 27th April, 2005 at 6:30 pm.

At this meeting members of the Association Committee will be elected. The members of the committee are then nominated to become members of the School Board of Governors. All current parents of TIS are automatically members of the School Association and are eligible for nomination and election.

Parents' Consultative Group Nominations

Hopefully parents will recall the previous notice that we are starting a Parent Consultative Group (PCG) at TIS.

The aim of the PCG is to provide parents with an opportunity to discuss any areas of interest or concern regarding their child's education and other aspects of school life.

The PCG will consist of two parents from each class in the school, elected by the parents of that class.

- Members must be parents or guardians of TIS students.
- Both parents from a family may stand for election but only one parent or guardian per family may become a member of the PCG.
- Teachers at TIS or School Board members are not eligible to become PCG members.

It is hoped that the group will reflect the composition of the school community.
